It is understood that the following regulations must be followed and that they will be strictly enforced. Driving and parking a car on school property is a privilege subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Students will need to pay for a parking permit each year at the cost of \$5.00, which off sets the cost of having the permits made. Students may purchase the permit at pre-registration.
- 2. The permit must be hanging from the inside rearview mirror.
- 3. Student cars must park in the designated student parking areas only of the main high school lot. Absolutely no student parking in the areas designated for the handicapped, visitors and staff.
- 4. Student permits are to be used for the assigned vehicle only. NOTE: If a student must drive another family vehicle as an exception, just transfer the permit temporarily. But if there is a vehicle change, please make sure the office is notified of the change (edit this form in the office).
- 5. The administration reserves the right to search cars when they have reasonable suspicion to believe the car contains illegal substances or objects that violate school rules.
- 6. All cars are to be locked and not moved during school hours.
- 7. Driving the vehicle in a reckless and dangerous manner or using the car to violate school rules (like skipping, etc.) will cause loss of driving privileges.
- 8. No sitting, sleeping, loitering, etc. in vehicles during school hours, before or after school. Student drivers are responsible for their vehicles at all times. They are not to allow other students to be in their vehicles during school hours without prior parental and office permission.
- 9. The vehicle must be properly insured and safe to operate.
- 10. No unauthorized person may drive a vehicle when driving privileges have been suspended.
- 11. Students are not allowed to ride on the hood, trunk or running boards. Riding in the back of open bed pickups is considered highly dangerous, and therefore, strictly prohibited.
