

## How to Open an .rtf file type in Google Docs

Overview: An .rtf file is a Rich Text Format file. It is commonly used for files that have text, and it is compatible on most text viewing/editing programs.

1. Go to a Moodle class and look for a link that has an icon next to it that looks like a *blank white sheet of paper*. Most of these are typically .rtf files



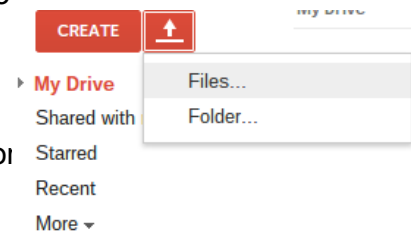
2. Click on the file that you would like to view.

The file will download when you click on it. It should appear on the downloads bar at the bottom of your browser. If it doesn't appear, it will be in your *Downloads* folder when you click on the Files icon.



3. Please do not open the file after it has downloaded. You will receive an error.

Next you will want to move the file into your Google Drive. To do this, you can open Google Drive and upload the file, or you can click-and-drag on the file to move it into Google Drive.



**To Upload:** Go to your Google Drive and look for the upload icon. When you click on it, choose *Files...* Select the .rtf file and click *Open*.

4. Once the file is in your Google Drive,  
1. Check the box next to it.  
2. Click on the button titled, *More*.  
3. Click on *Open with*.  
4. Select *Google Docs*.  
Your file should open in a new Google Doc.
